For parents whose children are in the preschool and will be going to school in September

Our preschool children who are going to school in September have been busy practising their leavers performance ready to show all of you and they are all very excited. We now have a date for when this will take place; their performance will be on **Thursday 14th July at 4:30pm**. For children who do not attend nursery on this day, please drop your child off at nursery for 3:30pm.

Also, we would like to take a group photo of the children leaving for school, could you please let us know if you are happy for your child to be in this and then we can let every child have a copy of this to keep.

Your child's government funding will finish on the 19th August, we are still waiting for some families to confirm when your child's last day will be. Could you please let us know as soon as possible, otherwise you will be invoiced for the last 2 weeks of August.

<u>30 hour funding information for new applications</u>

If your child will be entitled to extended funding from September this is the case if your child turns 3 between April and August 2022 - please ensure that you apply for this by the middle of July. Oxfordshire is changing the funding portal for nursery from August and therefore nursery will need to submit the eligible children by the end of July.

After you have completed the online portal, please can you also email Andrea the following information, all together in the same email:

<u>Staffing</u>
